My mission is to provide strategic support for academic careers – with clarity, structure, and a collaborative approach at eye level. I have already accompanied several scholars on their career paths, and I successfully coached one colleague to a professorship within a year.

An academic career is comparable to a mountain expedition: if you do not plan your route in advance, you risk detours, uncertainty – or missing the summit altogether. In the HABIL Peer Colloquium™, you can approach your “route planning” in a structured and well-supported way: through dedicated spaces for reflection, targeted impulses, peer exchange, and my individual guidance.
